Transportation to Bodrum

The central location of the Summer School provides many alternatives for transport around the city. There are many transportation options for those who plan to travel to Bodrum by plane. You can follow the steps below for affordable transportation:

- You can use HAVAS BUS (<https://havas.net/>) which is running between airport and Bodrum Torba Bus Station). You can pay cash to HAVAS BUS. HAVAS provides service for all arriving flights.
- Then, you can transit with another bus (Bus for Gümbet) from Bodrum Torba Bus Station to Serpina Hotel. You can either pay cash, or with credit card or buy a prepaid and reloadable travel card called 'Muglakart' which is valid in all cities of Mugla. You can use "Muglakart App" for reload the card. Please note that the application requires an internet connection.
- It is possible to travel between Torba Bus station to go to Bodrum Chamber of Commerce (Konacık) with the same bus lines alternative.
- Alternatively, if you wish to ride a private taxi from the airport to the Serpina Hotel, it costs around 400 Turkish Liras.



In addition, there will be free bus service which will run between Serpina Hotel and Bodrum Chamber of Commerce on a daily base:

- from Serpina Hotel to the Summer School Venue at 8.30 in the morning,
- from the Summer School Venue to Serpina Hotel at 14.30.



PS: If you prefer to stay anywhere else you can either take the bus to and from Serpina Hotel; or alternatively, you can directly come to the Summer School venue.

Accommodation

Participants are free to stay where they want. Alternatively, Limited number of rooms are reserved at the Serpina Hotel www.serpinahotel.com in Gümbet/Bodrum for the summer module participants with a special rate. Please note that the accommodation capacity is limited at the Serpina Hotel and the rooms will be allocated on a 'first come first serve' basis. When all the rooms are booked at Serpina Hotel, then we will reserve rooms with similar conditions (in and around Gümbet, 3 star hotels).

Catering and Dining

During the Summer School coffee and tea will be serviced and food will not be served. It is recommended to have strong breakfast.



Electrical Appliances

The voltage is **220V** throughout Turkey. Double round pin plugs are used and you are advised to bring with you any **adapters** you may need for your electrical appliances (such as mobile phone, laptop, hairdryer, etc.).

Currency and Shopping

There are cash machines and exchange centers in many parts of Bodrum. Credit cards are widely accepted in shops and restaurants (ID is required); however, smaller establishments may not accept cards and you are advised to carry at least some cash for daily expenses. Participants are advised to change any foreign currency into Turkish Lira either in their home countries or upon their arrival at the airport (make sure you have enough time to do so).

Health and Safety

Please note that you are solely responsible to ensure sufficient health insurance coverage for the duration of your stay in Bodrum/Turkey. The participants are advised to take the necessary precautions and bring necessary medication with them.
